- Applications must be received or postmarked by the dates listed on this application.
- Applications received after the published due date will be considered for the following selection period. Please refer to the schedule on the application.
- Applications are reviewed once per quarter by the FEAT scholarship committee*
- One application per child, please. No exceptions.
- Proof of an autism diagnosis is required to apply
Acceptable documentation:
 - Front page of the child's IEP or
 - A one page diagnosis letter from the child's physician
- All children enrolled at Sport Social must be evaluated by the Sport Social staff for placement in the proper program. This includes all FSS scholarship winners.
- Scholarships will NOT be awarded until the child is evaluated and placed in the proper program.
- If the evaluation results in a child being ineligible for services (ie; extreme aggression to self and others), the scholarship will be awarded to another family.
- Failure to have your child evaluated within 21 days of the scholarship award date will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.
- The FEAT scholarship committee selects three children per quarter, twelve children per year.
- Scholarship winners are informed by email or phone by a member of the scholarship committee.
- The scholarship award date is noted on the award letter provided by the award committee.
- Scholarship committee members, Sport Social employees, FEAT board members or relatives of Scholarship committee members cannot apply.
- All contact information is kept private and will not be shared with anyone outside the FEAT scholarship committee.
- Scholarships will be credited to the Sport Social account of the child named in the application only.
- Scholarships cannot be redeemed for cash or merchandise.
- Scholarship credit is assigned to one child only, it is NOT transferable.
- Scholarship credit is good for 12 months from the award date.
- Scholarship Credit can be used in a one month time period or spread out over several months.
- Scholarship funds are to only be used for the Sport Social program(s) deemed appropriate by the Sport Social staff.
- FEAT reserves the right to change the scholarship amount at any time. This does not apply to scholarships already awarded.

**The FEAT scholarship committee is composed of three individuals. One FEAT board member and two other individuals selected by the FEAT board. Committee members cannot have a child enrolled at or be an employee of Sport Social.

Our mission is to provide information on treatment resources for families with children diagnosed with autism, autism spectrum disorder (ASD), and related disorders. We provide support, encouragement, and guidance to parents and create an opportunity for them to benefit from contact with other parents with similar needs and concerns.
